

April 2024 prayer diary

MONDAY 1 APRIL

- Pray that teenagers away on Easter camps will have a great time and pay attention to the teaching
- Pray that students away over Easter will be an encouragement to their home churches and believing family and good witnesses to unbelieving family
- Give thanks for some good Sylheti outreach in Mile End Park last month. Pray that conversations and seeds sown will be remembered, and that people might make their way to nearby churches, including Asha

TUESDAY 2 APRIL

- Give thanks for the guests who attended the Messiah concert at St Michael's last month. Pray
 that any who took a Gospel away will read it from beginning to end
- Give thanks for the recent 4pm men's breakfast thinking about prayer. Pray they will grow in excitement at the privilege of prayer, and boldness as they look to our heavenly father who can do more than all we ask or imagine (Eph 3:20)

WEDNESDAY 3 APRIL

- Give thanks for some Sylheti ladies at Asha being particularly struck by Jesus' mercy to sinners, outcasts, blind men and little children. Pray they will call out to Jesus for mercy. Pray too that more men will come
- The Shantir Boi bookshop has moved from Brick Lane to the Asha venue in Limehouse. Pray that this location will work well and be a means to reach new people

THURSDAY 4 APRIL

- Give thanks for the ReNew Regional Leaders; pray for them to be steadfast in their own guarding of the gospel and for their encouragement of others in their regions
- Pray for believers living in countries where it is dangerous to meet together. Pray they will find ways to have fellowship and to grow as disciples of Jesus
- Pray that the Lord will enable Christians around the world who face rejection by their families or communities to remain faithful to him

FRIDAY 5 APRIL

- Pray for the Asha team, who run book tables in Watney Market each Friday, seeking to hold out the word of life to the predominantly Muslim community
- Pray for a group of IGG students going away on "Lads in a House"; for significant times in God's word, and for partnership in the gospel to be strengthened
- The Kamuku translation team are in Jos to continue linguistics training with Katharine. Pray for them as they apply what they are learning to the books that have been translated

SATURDAY 6 APRIL

- Give thanks for dialogue events hosted by church family last month. Pray for follow up opportunities, including invitations to the "If you could ask God one question" week of talks events
- Myriam is leading a workshop on "Comparison, Envy and Competition" at the annual women's convention, Charleroi (Belgium); James is teaching on prayer at a church plant in Bordeaux

SUNDAY 7 APRIL

- Pray for the 10 & 10.30am (William on 1 Thess 2:9-16), 2pm Mandarin (Henry on Eph 2:4-7),
 4pm (Aneirin on Judges 17 & 18), and 6pm (Tim on Daniel 9) meetings
- Pray that the children will have confidence that Jesus is building his kingdom as they look at Acts in Sunday School this term
- The 4pm women's reading group meets today to discuss "Five Lies of Our Anti-Christian Age".
 Pray that they will be strengthened in their conviction of the truth of God's word in the face of a culture that is increasingly set against it
- Asha are looking Luke 24 to focus on the resurrection of Jesus

MONDAY 8 APRIL

Mission partner news

St Helen's sends out and supports individuals and families involved in cross-cultural Christian ministry, both overseas and in this country. We are also linked with national Christians and churches overseas. Below is a focus on one of our Mission Partners.
